# The Trojan Horse of Terrorism, by Paul R. Hollrah, March 11, 2017, Excerpts, Submitted by Don O'Nesky

On March 7, 2017, the *New York Times* reported that "Europe's simmering backlash against immigration came into sharp relief on Tuesday when the Hungarian Parliament approved the detention of asylum seekers in guarded and enclosed camps on the country's southern border, in what human rights advocates called a reckless breach of international law."

The Prime Minister <u>Viktor Orban</u> justified the measure on the grounds that it would secure the European Union's borders from migrants and act as a powerful deterrent against migration, which he called the 'Trojan horse of terrorism.' Orban said, "We are under seige. This is the reality, which cannot be overruled by charming human rights nonsense."

Unfortunately, "charming human rights nonsense" now forms immigration policy on the political left in the United States, just as it has in most Western European nations. While liberals and Democrats oppose any and all limitations on immigration from majority Muslim countries... in the apparent hope that American Muslims will repay the favor by becoming a reliable Democratic voting bloc... even they express concern over the potential for isolated terror attacks in the near term. What apparently escapes their attention is the clearly stated long term goal of Muslim migration: the complete domination of Islam over all the nations of the world.

In his first speech before a joint session of Congress on February 28, President Trump paused, gazed directly into the camera, and carefully enunciated words that Barack Obama famously refused to utter. He said, "Our obligation is to *serve*, *protect*, and *defend* the citizens of the United States... We are also taking strong measures to protect our nation from *radical Islamic terrorism*."

However, as appealing and as essential as that resolve might be, by focusing only on the unspeakable atrocities of *radical* Islamists, we run the risk of overlooking or downplaying what is an even more deadly and more pervasive long-term threat: the danger of what Hungarian Prime Minister Orban referred to as the "Trojan horse of terrorism," the unfettered flow of Muslim migrants and refugees across international frontiers into the Western world.

In his book, Slavery, Terrorism, and Islam: The Historical Roots and Contemporary Threat, Dr. Peter Hammond explains something that every Christian, every Jew, and every other non-Muslim on the face of the Earth must understand... that Islam does not qualify as a religion in the normally accepted sense of the word. Instead, as a complete legal, political, economic, social, and military system with a religious component, the West's dangerous flirtation with multiculturalism can only be described as "charming human rights nonsense."

Reciprocal freedom of worship is a naive pipedream. While a few majority Muslim nations have tolerated Christian congregations in their midst, many of those Christians are now victims of genocide. To expect that those attitudes will ever change is worse than naı̈ve... it is dangerous and it is suicidal.

By the end of this century, Muslims could exceed 50 percent of the world's population. But long before that time, it is reasonable to assume that most of 21<sup>st</sup> century Western civilization will have become unraveled and our descendants will find themselves facing a squalid 7<sup>th</sup> century lifestyle. As Prime Minister Orban so aptly describes it, the current level of Muslim immigration into the West can best be described as the "Trojan horse of terrorism." Left unfettered, it can have no good end. As matters now stand, we cannot assume that the Europe we have known and loved for many centuries, and from which our forebears emerged, will continue to exist beyond 10 or 20 more years.

While Europe may be the "cradle of the modern constitutional state, the treasure house of human rights, of freedom of opinion and expression," the United States is the laboratory in which those concepts were tested and proven. That fact, alone, gives Islamists all the justification they need to see us wiped from the face of the Earth. There is far too much at stake to be gambled away in some "charming human rights" experiment, in a contest we cannot win. And if we are so unwise as to invite the forces of Islam to coexist with us, on our own soil, then we too, like Europe, will crumble from within.

# Stunning Win – Exxon Mobil Will Invest \$20 Billion Building New Refineries, Conservative Treehouse, Posted on March 6, 2017 by Sundance, Excerpts

This is YUGE news and will impact each and every American. One of the missing elements in our quest for energy independence has always been the lack of oil refining capacity to produce gasoline and other fuel end-products.

Years of choking fossil fuel regulation, partly funded and supported by an alignment of special interests including foreign governments, OPEC and eco lobbyists, has created a situation where over half of our oil refining capability was eliminated. With the election, and independence, of Donald Trump that course has changed dramatically. Trump is not beholden to the lobbyists and special interests who pay for the U.S. to remain dependent on foreign oil and off shore refinement.

Exxon Mobil Corp (XOM.N), the world's largest publicly traded oil producer, said on Monday it would invest \$20 billion through 2022 to expand its chemical and oil refining plants on the U.S. Gulf Coast. The investments at 11 sites should create 35,000 temporary construction jobs and 12,000 permanent jobs, Chief Executive Darren Woods said in a speech at CERAWeek, the world's largest gathering of energy executives. "The supply is here. The demand is there. We want to keep connecting those dots," Woods said.

U.S. President Donald Trump, who tapped former Exxon CEO Rex Tillerson for secretary of state, praised the company's spending plans as an example of "a true American success story." Most of the permanent jobs are expected to pay more than \$100,000 per year. "This is exactly the kind of investment, economic development and job creation that will help put Americans back to work," Trump said

Gorka: An Upstanding Citizen or Immigrant on Monday Doesn't Decide to Become a Jihadi on Tuesday, Breitbart News Daily, March 23, 2017, Excerpts

Dr. Sebastian Gorka, deputy adviser to President Donald Trump and former National Security editor for Breitbart News, discussed the London terror attack with SiriusXM host Raheem Kassam.

"We need to note that for jihadists, dates are very important: 9/11 itself was the anniversary of a great defeat against jihadi fighters centuries ago. The fact that this happened on the anniversary of the Brussels attack really should not have surprised anybody." Gorka said.

"These aren't things that are coming out of the blue sky. These are methodologies that are being propagated and promoted by ISIS. This is how they think. They're not interested in investing millions of dollars and time and energy and expertise in weapons of mass destruction. They're going low-investment, high-yield – whether it's stealing a truck in France and plowing into almost 90 people, whether it's buying a knife and slashing people on the streets of Tel Aviv or Jerusalem. This is their new modus operandi. It costs nothing, and it is devastating," he said.

Gorka said jihadis would continue to exploit the Western world's vulnerability to these cheap and deadly truck and knife attacks until "the chattering classes think that they should ban vehicles the same way banning guns will make us safe."

"This is the beauty of this attack: it's not about the everyday item, the inanimate object. It's about the person driving it or using it. That's why good counter-terrorism isn't reactive; it is preventative," Gorka argued. "That's why you have to find these people, use human intelligence. Here in the United States, we've taken the step of our travel moratorium to stop people coming from war zones who want to use these kinds of tactics against us. Now there will be the focus on all kinds of diversionary issues, not the fact that this individual was already on the radar screen of the security services a year ago.



Gorka said there has "never been a case of an upstanding citizen or immigrant on Monday deciding on Tuesday to become a jihadi and killing his fellow citizens. There's always a progression. There's always a digestion of jihadi ideology. There's always some kind of statement of sympathy for the things that the bad guys are doing. That's how we find them. That's how we prevent the next attack," he declared.

"On the Left, reality is optional. This isn't about objective truth. It's always been about narrative," he elaborated. "For the last eight years, unfortunately, out of the White House, they've been spinning this narrative. We've got to be super careful because if we don't understand why this attack happened, we truly will become inured to these events," he warned. "People will die, and then 24 hours later, we're going to go back to business as usual."

"The bottom line is this doesn't happen because of grievances. This doesn't happen because of unemployment or under-education. It happens because evil walks the earth. The Left will deny that. Their multiculturalism, their post-modernist relativism, denies the existence of evil. That's why they were unqualified to fight this threat," he said.

In contrast, Gorka said the Trump administration "understands people like yesterday's attacker, the 7/7 bombers, Fort Hood, San Bernardino are a product of incarnate evil," adding, "And we will defeat it, Raheem."
